TO: ALL PERSONS WHO PURCHASED PCS EDVENTURES!.COM, INC. ("PCS"), COMMON STOCK ON OR ABOUT MARCH 28, 2007 THROUGH AND INCLUDING AUGUST 15, 2007:

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that pursuant to an order of the United States District Court for the District of Idaho, a hearing will be held on February 22, 2012, at 1:00 p.m. before the United States District Court for the District of Idaho, 550 West Fort Street, Room 400, Boise, ID 83724, for the purpose of determining (1) whether the proposed settlement of the Action for the sum of \$665,000 in cash should be approved by the Court as fair, reasonable, and adequate; (2) whether, thereafter, this Action should be dismissed with prejudice against the Defendants as set forth in the Stipulation of Settlement; (3) whether the Plan of Allocation of settlement proceeds should be approved; and (4) the reasonableness of the application of Plaintiffs' Lead Counsel for the payment of attorneys' fees and expenses incurred in connection with this Action, together with interest thereon.

If you purchased PCS common stock on or about March 28, 2007 through and including August 15, 2007, your rights may be affected by this Action and the settlement thereof. If you have not received a detailed Notice of Proposed Settlement of Class Action and a copy of the Proof of Claim and Release, you may obtain copies by writing to Niederklein v. PCS Edventures!.com, Inc., Claims Administrator, c/o A.B. Data, Ltd., PO Box 170500, Milwaukee, WI 53217-8091, or by downloading this information at abdataclassaction.com/Cases.aspx. If you are a Class Member, in order to share in the distribution of the Net Settlement Fund, you must submit a Proof of Claim and Release postmarked no later than 90 calendar days after entry of the preliminary approval order, by January 3, 2012, establishing that you are entitled to a recovery. You will be bound by any judgment rendered in the Action unless you request to be excluded, in writing, to the above address, postmarked by February 8, 2012.

Any objection to any aspect of the settlement must be received by the Clerk of the Court no later than 14 calendar days before the date of the Settlement Fairness Hearing, by February 8, 2012, and **received** by the following no later than February 8, 2012:
